

Principal's Annual Report

2025 - 2026

This report was prepared with a reflective spirit-looking back on our accomplishments to date, while also sharing recent activity in a variety of key administrative domains.

The mid-term report showcases and improvements and glories of our school, undoubtedly, but also makes us think deeply about our shortcomings, corrections and improvement to make as go ahead. The second half of the academic session represents an interesting period for the school. As we close out the first half of the year and prepare for the second, we find ourselves thinking about how to build on our successes thus far. School-wide, our primary focus has been on pursuing academic excellence, though the systems we have implemented to support student achievement are constantly under review. We remain committed to having authentic conversations about what our students need most, how best to support their learning, how to support our teachers, and how to assume a general posture of continued and perpetual betterment. For some of these questions, we have answers—while others remain somewhat elusive. However, Administration feels comfortable about the direction that we are moving and the accomplishments we have made to date.

The proverbial start of school” celebratory” period is over and the teachers and students are all engaged in the teaching and learning process. Our recent half-yearly examination results formed a baseline for each student to indicate progress over the course of the year. **A summary of these test results is attached to this report.**

Subject benchmark exams have been Administered with the blueprint design prepared by the Principal K.JOSE GEO .Performance result were tabulated and parent/teacher conferences were scheduled for PT- I. Half-yearly and PT II to engage in a conversation regarding academic and behavior progress with all families. A combination of professional observations and evaluations by SMC, each teacher, Correspondent and Principal along with standardized test scores from the nucleus of these discussions. These important dialogues help form a team of parents and teachers to support and encourage each student in their educational experience.

We believe that the success of instituted programs such as remedial classes, bridge gap classes, extra classes are showing up in these exam results.

Academic: Major Accomplishments through January, 2025

*** Planning and preparation:** A lesson plan schedule and template were introduced and implemented. This helped to establish accountability, consistency and instructional growth.

***Observation and Feedback:** A three-part observation cycle(pre-observation conference, informal observation and post-observation conference) was designed to raise the level of reflective planning and teaching. Every teacher has had at least two observations during this process. Formal observations were completed for every teacher in the building and returned with areas of strength and areas of growth.

***Performance Evaluation:** Assessments of PT I, Half-yearly and PT II were done- Every student was assessed using CBSE Grade criteria and progress monitoring was in place for all students who were in need of that support. Benchmarks were created and circulated in each grade level in the areas of all main subjects. Teachers will use this data to review or reteach concepts that students did not understand or did not retain.

***Professional Development:** Teachers have had professional development on performance Standards, teaching skills, classroom instruction, time management, and the changes to literacy instruction, mathematical/ science practices common for all grades—**on ground the implementation of these skills is still wanting. Teachers will have additional differentiation training if needed in end of the March, 2026.**

*** Instructional Support:** Every grade level teacher received access to all subject materials, including digital live support and content mapped support for worksheets, question papers, question banks and teacher resources from Teach Next Education and our Academic Partners. **Once again I repeat—teachers taking advantage of these resources provided and making maximum use of them is questionable.**

OPERATIONS and FINANCE

Operations: One of the stated operational goals for 2025-26 was to create efficiencies that increase back office productivity. One critical component to achieving this goal required a redesigned website that would direct external inquiries to a virtual “home base” rather than to a contact person at the school. As a consequence we have leveraged a new and functional application that has helped accomplish our principal goal in addition to improving the school’s web presence.

The latest iteration of this initiative has been the launch of our online enrollment application. The response to this new web feature has been overwhelmingly positive. In one week, we have received upward of 150 applications spanning all grade levels.

Operations: Major Accomplishments through January 2025

***Communication and Efficiency:** Designed and launched a new school App equipped with new interactive features. Continued the use of social networking sites (Facebook/what sup) while adding a new communications medium to expand the reach of our communications methods.

*Successfully on- boarded new staff members (as per requirement).

*Successfully launched new Payroll system and re-established/transferred all major HR and Benefit processes with state and local officials.

*** The preparation of New Operational Policies: 1. The teachers Employment Agreement, 2.Almanac,3.School Prospectus , 4.Parent-student handbook-Underway.**

***Maintenance and Technology Requests:** Successful school-wide adoption of “Work Order Requests” for nonemergency maintenance and technology issues. The use of work orders has improved back-office efficiency by allowing small assignments &projects, which improves efficiencies when requiring the assistance of 3rd party vendors.

Finance:

It goes without saying that we have successfully navigated fairly rugged terrain with regard to finances through January2025. In spite of heavy outstanding fee we have managed well. Administration has been able to avoid staff layoffs or programmatic cuts that would impact the integrity of our academic program, RE: mandatory trainings, curricular resources and supplies, school events, co-curricular activities, school trips and all regular expenses and unexpected liabilities(facility maintenance costs) are being addressed, accordingly. Additionally, while the primary driver of our revenue is student enrollment, it has been more important than ever that we maintain our total student population-which we have. Furthermore, it is difficult to determine why or how we have been able to retain students at a higher than in year’s past, but anecdotally it appears that interest in our middle school has risen.

Human Resource

As has been the case in the beginning months after PT-I.Administration has been preoccupied with personnel matters—namely, identifying, vetting, and on-boarding new hires following unexpected resignations. Allow the record to reflect that the Administration considers mid-year resignations (barring extraordinary circumstances) to be particularly egregious and professionally unacceptable. Aside from actions of this sort being particularly difficult to manage they are especially challenging for children. They also weaken the confidence of our parents. To that end, we expect all staff members to honor their employment agreements for the entirety of given school-year. That said, the loss of professionals have allowed us to rearticulate the roles and responsibilities for the position. To date, all of the previously reported vacant positions have been filled
